INTERVIEW QUESTIONS

1. Can you tell us a bit about your background and what inspired you to become a writer?

As a kid, I loved to read anything that had a happy ending.. When I was a teenager I read my first Harlequin and said, "I'm a good writer. I can do that."

2. Your debut novel, "Too Dangerous to Love," is quickly becoming a fan favorite with reviewers. What inspired the story and the unique concept of bionic soldiers in the Project VIPER Series?

In 2016, a friend showed me *Always Loyal*—a book featuring photographs of wounded U.S. Gulf War veterans taken by photographer Michael Stokes. As I flipped through the beautiful pages, I said to myself, "those are heroes I want to write happily ever afters for," and the VIPER series was born.

3. The relationship between Dr. Scarlett Kerrigan and Navy SEAL Commander Chris Daviani is at the heart of your book. What do you think makes their dynamic so compelling for readers?

I love an opposites attract romance.

4. In "Too Dangerous to Love," you explore themes of resilience and the power of love. Can you share your thoughts on these themes and how they play out in your story?

Falling in love requires trust, and giving someone your trust is hard after you've been hurt.

As for my writing zone, the earlier I get up in the morning, the more I write. I'm in the zone when it's still dark out and the house is quiet.

14. What's next on your writing journey? Are there any exciting projects or releases in the pipeline that you can share with us?

Knife to the Heart, Book 1 in the Blood Snow series releases in February. This book is an action-packed romance about a cybersecurity attack on a hospital in a Colorado ski town. When the hospital's CEO and a determined FBI agent clash,
